


# Paint & Blend brushes for Procreate



This is a brush set with 11 brushes for Procreate (minimum required Procreate 5). All brushes have an average blending. Redistribution and modification is allowed, but not the commercial use.

Why average blending? To blend colors without the need to smudge pixels around. This is the default blending mode used by the apps Clip Studio Paint and Paint Tool Sai.

Procreate 5 DON'T have average blending. However you can trick it, and create brushes with pure color mixing without smudge pixels around your canvas.

The trick is to use Dual Brushes. The first brush serve purely as a 'zone average blending'; this brush can't have any shape, flow or opacity variation. The second brush serve as masking and brush behaviour. This way, you can create smoother blending and any kind of shape brush.

These brushes are optimized to work ONLY with Apple Pencil (1st or 2nd gen). It will NOT work with third party stylus or your finger.

## How to use:

Just install the brushset (opening it in the Files app on your iPad), paint and enjoy. With lower Pencil pressure or Pencil tilt you will BLEND. With higher Pencil pressure you will PAINT; anything between will create smooth and nice color gradation and blending.

## How to create new brushes like these:

Duplicate any of these brushes and change the Secondary brush parameters.

Or...

Duplicate any of these brushes and delete Secondary brush. Duplicate any existing brush -single brush, not dual brush-, for example the default Nikko Rull. Select the first brush then multiselect the existing brush. Press 'Combine'. You may need to refine the Secondary brush parameters, specially Flow and opacity controls and -maybe- rendering type. You may need to change the Spacing and Scatter parameters; must be the same (aprox.) in both brushes.
